1. **Courses.** The institutions offers undergraduate programs in Engineering/ Natural Sciences/ Management & Entrepreneurship/ Humanities & Social Sciences. Details of programs/ subjects can be accessed from the University website www.snuadmissions.com.

2. **Fee Concession/ Reservation of Seats for Naval Wards.**

(a) Concession in Tuition fees to the extent of **100%** for **upto 2 wards of naval personnel died in harness.**

(b) Concession in Tuition fees to the extent of **75%** for **upto 3 wards of serving naval personnel.**

(c) Concession in Tuition fees to the extent of **50%** for **upto 3 wards of retired naval personnel.**

(d) Hostel accommodation charges, one time Admission fee, refundable security, mess and laundry charges will not be the part of the above arrangement.

3. **Scholarships.**

(a) Over and above the agreed fee concession/ scholarships, the students can apply for other scholarships available to general candidates and are subject to change from time to time as per the discretion of the university.

(b) The fee concession/ scholarships mentioned above shall be awarded to students that are shortlisted after completing the admissions process (including any specific eligibility required for the specific program) of the university for the specific Admission year.

(c) The said fee concession/ scholarships are also applicable to wards of naval personnel who may be posted abroad on special missions/ duties.

(d) Students will have to maintain the specified CGPA as per the university norms for the continuation of the scholarship. In case, the specified CGPA is not maintained, the special scholarship awarded may be withdrawn in line with the Scholarship Policy of the university.

Selection Procedure.

4. The concessions mentioned above shall be awarded to students who are shortlisted after completing the admission process (including eligibility required for a particular program) of the University for the specific Admissions year. The extant procedure for registration/ admissions at Shiv Nadar Institution of Eminence is as follows (subject to amendments by the University from time to time. Prospective candidates are advised to refer to the website of the University www.snuadmissions.com for latest information/ instructions regarding admissions):-

(a) **School of Engineering.**

Route 1. JEE Mains 2023 or 2022 (years as applicable in future). High performers may be offered direct admissions based on their JEE (Mains) score in 2023 or 2022 (years as applicable in future). Shortlisted candidates may be called for an interview.

Route 2. SNU Scholastic Assessment Test (SNUSAT) + Academic Proficiency Test (APT)

Route 3. College Board Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) + Interview - The candidates can apply with their SAT score if they have taken the SAT.

Route 4. American College Testing (ACT) + Interview - The candidates can apply with their ACT score if they have taken the ACT.

(b) **School of Natural Sciences.**

Route 1. JEE Mains 2023 or 2022 (years as applicable in future) + Interview

Selection Procedure.

3. Wards of *IN* personnel desirous of availing the above concessions are to complete the due procedure as laid down by the University for registration and obtain confirmation of admission. The extant procedure for registration/ admissions at FLAME University is as follows:-
 - (a) Students need to register themselves by paying a non-refundable fee of Rs 2,000/- (or as prescribed by the University from time to time), on the FLAME University website **www.flame.edu.in**
 - (b) After registration, students are to fill in personal/ academic particulars and upload photographs and academic and extra-curricular certificates.
 - (c) Students need to answer three questions under the Statement of Purpose (SOP) category.
 - (d) After filling up the application, uploading of documents and answering SOP questions, candidates will receive an email from the University intimating the schedule of the entrance test - FLAME Entrance Aptitude Test (FEAT). FEAT is a 120 min online exam in which 100 minutes will be allocated for objective part (Verbal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, Basic Mathematics and General Knowledge) and 20 minutes will be allocated for Essay.
 - (e) Post completion of FEAT, students will receive an email from the University for an Interview, which would also be conducted online.

(f) Selected students will receive an offer letter by email, about 15 days after the interview.

(g) **Eligibility criteria**. Minimum 50% in class 12 for Under Graduate program. However, students can apply with their Class 10 and Class 11 marks for the UG program as the results of class 12 would not be available during application.

On receipt of offer letter from FLAME University, candidates are to forward application for fee concession as per the prescribed proforma (**Appendix A**) as well as an Undertaking (**Appendix B**) by email to **nwwacentral@gmail.com**. 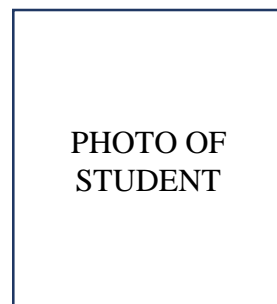
